## Pastor's COLUMN

### The ponderings of your pastor...

To continue the theme of gifts, from last month, which God has given to us, I am reminded of a story I heard.

One day, a young man had to face a judge for a crime he had committed. He was truly sorry for what he had done and was committed to face his judgement with a repentant heart. As he entered the courtroom, the judge was sitting on the judgement seat. The young man began to feel the fear of facing the judgment. Then the judge asked the young man if he was sorry for what he had done. The young man said yes, he was and was ready to face the consequences for what he had done. The judge said the penalty was \$300 or thirty days in jail. The young man said to the judge, "I have no money, so I will have to accept the thirty days in jail. Awaiting the Judge to pronounce the final judgement, the young man was stunned to see the Judge stand up, take off his robe and come down from the judgment seat, take out his wallet, and pay the fine.

Of course, this is a story and not a true event, however, there is an event in which this occurred, and it happened for you, me, and all of humanity. The truth is we all have a judgement against us. We all have committed a crime, and

that crime is against the one true Judge of the universe, God. The crime committed is sin, our failure to keep the commandments, the laws which the judge has set before us. 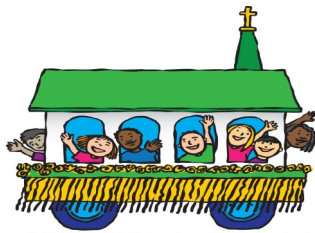

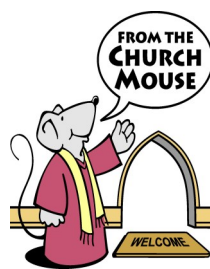

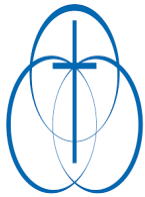
